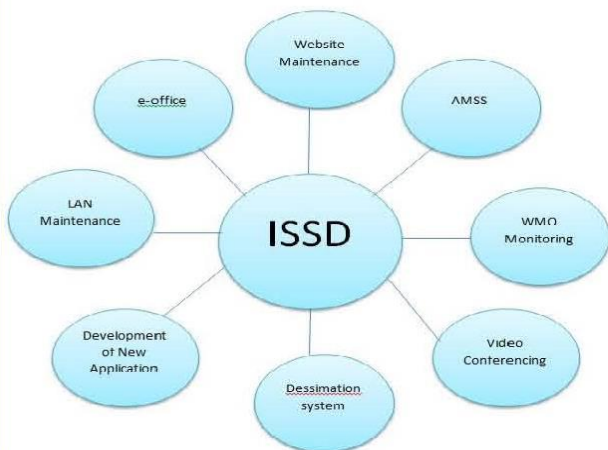


Mandate

- E-office is being implemented in IMD as a policy of Government of India for efficient and paperless administration and e-governance.

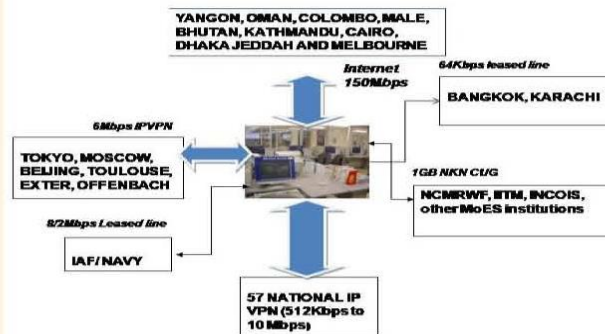
Video Conferencing

Brief History of ISSD

Communication is the founding division of IMD HQ with the name Northern Hemisphere Exchange Centre (NHEC) which has renamed as ISSD in 2009. ISSD has six regional **Message Switching Centers** at airports of Delhi, Kolkata, Chennai, Mumbai, Nagpur and Guwahati. Also has **Global Information System Centre** (GISC) along with mirror RTH at Pune. GTS links with Regional Telecommunication Hub (RTH) New Delhi consists of 18 international circuits.

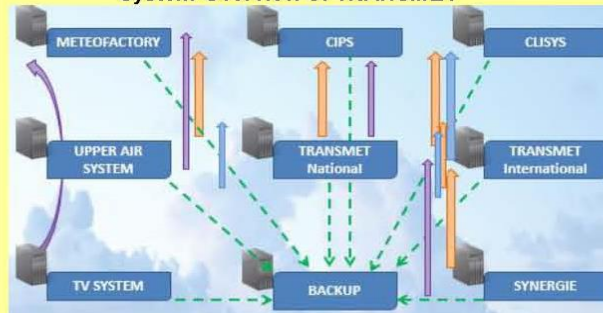


Communication links with countries and Organizations

National-International Collaboration

ISSD manages 6Mbps IPVPN link with Tokyo, Moscow, Beijing etc. and Melbourne through 150 Mbps internet at New Delhi end. Other international links Bangkok and Karachi are operating at 64 Kbps leased line.
